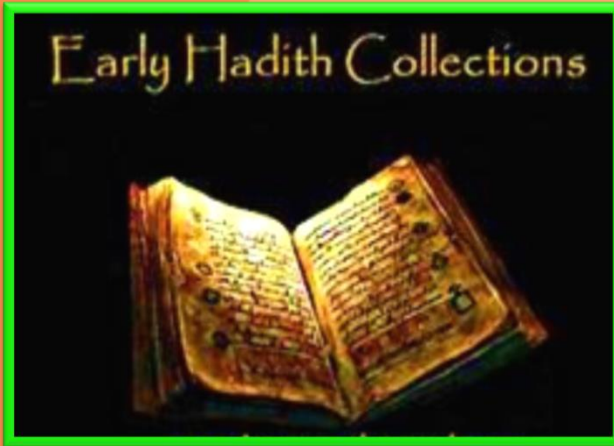

PROPHET MUHAMMAD ﷺ IS ALSO REPORTED TO HAVE SAID:-

- People are not aware of the excellence of the month of Sha'baan, the month that comes between the months of Rajab and Ramadaan.
- In this month, the actions of the people are presented to Allah ﷻ. I wish my actions to be presented whilst I am among those who are fasting. (AGREED UPON)



It is reported from Hadrat Mu'adh bin Jabl رضي الله عنه , that Prophet Muhammad صلى الله عليه وسلم said:

“On the 15th night of Sha’baan, Allah سُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ وَبِحَمْدِهِ bestows his special attention on His entire creation. He then pardons His entire creation except an idolater and one who harbours enmity.”

(Tabraani Ibnu – Hibaan and Baihaqi)

It is believed that on this night - old books of deeds are kept away and new record books are started.

Births and deaths are also finalised.

Various Angels - are briefed, assigned and instructed by Allah ﷻ to complete their various duties.

On this night, those who
sincerely repent for their past
sins and seek forgiveness from
Allah ﷻ,

**ARE
PARDONED
AND
FORGIVEN**

**only by the Will,
Power and
Mercy of Allah ﷻ.**

Scholars have stated that it was on the 15th of Sha`baan that the Qiblah was changed from Masjidul Aqsa in Jerusalem to the Ka`bah in Makkah.

It is recommended to fast on the
13th, 14th and 15th of each month,
including Sha'baan,
as stated in the following Hadith:-

Abu Zar رضي الله عنه reported that the Messenger of Allah صلى الله عليه وسلم said:-

“O Abu Zar! When you fast 3 days in a month,
fast on the 13th, 14th and 15th.”

Tirmizi and Nasai.



Special care is taken in the sighting of the moon and proper records are maintained of its dates, so that accurate dates can be observed for the sighting of the moon for Ramadaan.





On the night of Laylatul Baraa'aah, it is advised to plead and Implore Allah ﷻ to pardon the deceased and all Muslims and it is rewarding to make ibaadah & remember the entire Ummah in your pious Du'aas
