




Hajj – the 5th Pillar of Islam performed in the month of <u>Dh</u>ul Hijjah



The days of Hajj begin on the 8^{th} through to the 12^{th} of <u>Dh</u>ul Hijjah. It becomes compulsory upon the one who can afford it meeting the requirements, once in a person's lifetime.

Fasting

When Prophet Muhammad ﷺ was asked about Fasting on the Day of `Arafaah (9th of <u>Dh</u>ul Hijjah), he (ﷺ) said: *"It compensates for the (minor) sins of the past year and the coming year." (Muslim)*

AYYAAM AT-TASHREEK - commences on the 9th of Dhul Hijjah

It is Wajib (incumbent) for every adult Muslim to recite the 'Takbeeraat of Tashreeq' once **after every Fard Salaah** performed with Jamaat or individually **from the Fajr of the 9th of** <u>Dh</u>**ul Hijjah to** `**Asr of the 13th of** <u>Dh</u>**ul Hijjah**.

"Allah is the Greatest, Allah is the Greatest. There is no god but Allah and Allah is the Greatest. Allah is the Greatest and to Allah belongs all Praise."

The Takbeeraat should be recited audibly by the males and softly by females.

`Eidul Adhaa & Al Ud-hiyyah - 10th of <u>Dh</u>ul Hijjah





The Day of `Eidul Adhaa (Festival of Sacrifice) is celebrated by Muslims on the 10th of <u>Dh</u>ul Hijjah. It is a day on which we honour the willingness of Prophet Ibraaheem and Ismaaeel and to readily obey the Command of Allah ******.

The slaughtering of a prescribed animal on the days of `Eidul Adhaa begins from after the `Eid Salaah on the 10th of <u>Dh</u>ul Hijjah till before the end of the 12th day of <u>Dh</u>ul Hijjah.

Prophet Muhammad ﷺ is said:

"There is nothing dearer to Allah 3% during the Days of Sacrifice than sacrificing of animals. The sacrificed animal shall come on the Day of Qiyaamah with its horns, hair & hooves (to be weighed in reward). The sacrifice is accepted by Allah 3% before the blood reaches the ground. Therefore, sacrifice with an open & happy heart." [Mishkaat]
