


Hajj – the 5th Pillar of Islam performed in the month of Dhul Hijjah

The days of Hajj begin on the 8th through to the 12th of Dhul Hijjah. It becomes compulsory upon the one who can afford it meeting the requirements, once in a person's lifetime.



Allah ﷻ says in Surah Aali `Imraan; Aayah 97:

”وَلِلّٰهِ عَلَى النَّاسِ
حُجُّ الْبَيْتِ مَنِ اسْتَطَاعَ
إِلَيْهِ سَبِيلًا”





Fasting

When Prophet Muhammad ﷺ was asked about Fasting on the Day of `Arafaah (9th of Dhul Hijjah), he (ﷺ) said: ***"It compensates for the (minor) sins of the past year and the coming year."*** (Muslim)



AYYAAM AT-TASHREEK - commences on the 9th of Dhul Hijjah

It is Wajib (incumbent) for every adult Muslim to recite the 'Takbeeraat of Tashreeq' once **after every Fard Salaah** performed with Jamaat or individually **from the Fajr of the 9th of Dhul Hijjah to `Asr of the 13th of Dhul Hijjah.**

The Takbeeraat should be recited audibly by the males and softly by females.




The Day of `Eidul Adhaa (Festival of Sacrifice) is celebrated by Muslims on the 10th of Dhul Hijjah. It is a day on which we honour the willingness of Prophet Ibraaheem عليه السلام and Ismaaeel عليه السلام, to readily obey the Command of Allah ﷻ.

The slaughtering of a prescribed animal on the days of `Eidul Adhaa begins from after the `Eid Salaah on the 10th of Dhul Hijjah till before the end of the 12th day of Dhul Hijjah.

Prophet Muhammad ﷺ is said:

“There is nothing dearer to Allah ﷻ during the Days of Sacrifice than sacrificing of animals. The sacrificed animal shall come on the Day of Qiyaamah with its horns, hair & hooves (to be weighed in reward). The sacrifice is accepted by Allah ﷻ before the blood reaches the ground. Therefore, sacrifice with an open & happy heart.” [Mishkaat]



Du`aa for returning Hujjaaj

The Sunnah Du`aa to make when
meeting someone returning from Hajj is:

قَبِلَ اللَّهُ حَجَّكَ وَغَفَرَ ذَنْبَكَ وَ أَخْلَفَ نَفَقَتَكَ

*“May Allah accept your Hajj,
forgive your sins, and recompense your expenses.”
(Tabraani)*
